Read: Genesis 22

Tuesday, February 28, 2012 :: The Rejection App

**Read:** 1 Samuel 15:10-35

**Think about this ...** When Israel called out for a King, God warned them that they would regret that decision. Sure enough, as soon as God grants their request and anoints Saul to be King, everyone saw what God was talking about. Saul did some stupid stuff and therefore, God rejected him as King and appointed David. When our priorities are not in line with God's there will be issues to deal with.

**Download:** "Polite Call Reject" (Free) - from what I can see, this allows you to reject a call but send a polite message in response.

Wednesday, February 29, 2012 :: The Golden App

Read: Haggai 2:6-9

**Think about this ...** This book of the Bible is found near the end of the Old Testament. In this brief reading, God reminds us that everything belongs to him. No matter what we have stored up for ourselves, it's all His. This mindset it important for the believer in God to understand at some point along their journey of knowing Him. How does this application influence our priorities?

**Download:** "MySword Bible" (Free) - this is a highly rated Bible for your device because it allows you cross reference much of your translations.

Thursday, March 1, 2012:: The Foot App

**Read:** Luke 10:38-42

**Think about this ...** Mary and Martha was very close sisters. We don't know their age but they were certainly old enough to help out around the house and they were avid followers of Jesus. Their family supported his ministry and they loved Him very much. As Jesus visited their house this day, Mary didn't want to work and prepare the meal while Martha knew her place was in the kitchen. Both had good priorities but only one of them was right. Which one are you?

**Download:** Search for a "sunshine wallpaper" and pick your favorite one. Allow the sun to shine on you and your device!

Friday, March 2, 2012 :: The First Love App

Read: Revelation 2:1-7

**Think about this ...** This letter was written to the Church in Ephesus but it applies to our lives today! Do you remember when you first started to follow the Lord and wonderful you felt? Your priorities had shifted toward Him and it was great. Do you still feel that way?
