Monday, March 12, 2012 :: **The Grace App**

Read: (choose at least 1) Luke 15:11-31; Romans 5; Ephesians 2

Think about this ... Luke 15: When I think of grace, I think of this story from the teachings of Jesus. I am amazed at the grace and love of the father who waited for his son and willingly accepted him upon his return. My natural inclination would be to teach a few lessons to the one who thought they knew it all and left. The lesson taught was one of grace and that inspires me today. Romans: Verse 8 slams me in the face every time! I've done nothing for the acceptance that God has given me. Grace comes from the Lord 100%!! Ephesians: Verses 8-10 tell the story for me—I'm a work in progress. I'm so blessed that God is patiently working me into his perfect plan.

Tuesday, March 13, 2012 :: **The Confession App**

Read: Matthew 16:13-20; John 20:24-31

Think about this ... There are many examples of confession in the New Testament. Peter's confession was deep and heartfelt. Jesus said that such a confession is the foundation of the church that he was building. You don't have to know much to share with others ... you just have to confess what you believe! Thomas's confession was not believing Jesus was the Messiah, but to allow his heart to believe before his hands could feel. We can't hear Jesus today. We can't touch him. But we are called to live like him and for him!!

Wednesday, March 14, 2012 :: **The Freedom App**

Read: Galatians 5

Think about this ... We are called to be free—free from sin, free from shame, free from religious domination. Grace and confession naturally lead us toward living as free people and not caught up guilt and oppression. The key to live with true spiritual freedom is found in obedience to the Holy Spirit. God's Spirit speaks directly to your heart and whispers truth to your soul. This truth can be heard by everyone but we must be quiet enough to hear it. What do you need freedom from today?

Thursday, March 15, 2012 :: **The Priorities App**

Read: John 41-42

Think about this ... When Jesus interacted with the woman from Samaria, he was breaking several social rules. Their conversation seems to be one of clarification over many things but ultimately Jesus asks her about her priorities. She had been living day to day, from man to man, and Jesus really just wanted to her to live for him. She felt Jesus' love over his wrath and judgment. All of this helped her realign her life according to God's plan and purposes.

Friday, March 16, 2012 :: **The Sabbath App**

Read: Mark 2:23-3:6

Think about this ... Finding rest and rhythm is difficult today. Too often we allow ourselves to get so overwhelmed that everything around us seems to rob us from truly living. This was not God's plan for us. We have made observance of the Sabbath to be legalistic but what we need to do is look for proper rhythm and rest. How can you discover that in your life this weekend?
