Passage: Genesis 3-4

Insight: The fall of mankind is a sad story because we were living in a perfect world—untainted by the disobedience of those living in it. In this account, we see the motives and by-products of sin and it's not pretty: desire, jealousy, blame, shame, pain (repeat).

Prayer Focus: Summer Youth Mission Trip

Passage: Genesis 6-9

Insight: The situation on Earth quickly deteriorated into a desperate situation. God's creation was on a collision course because of it's evil ways so God decides to hit reset. In the flood we see God's anger over sin but also his powerful provision in the midst of the storm.

My Thoughts ...

Thursday: 06.07.2012

Prayer Focus: The sick and recovering (iPray)

Passage: Genesis 21-22

Insight: God promised Abraham a great number of descendants but his wife was still barren—even at the age of 90. Wouldn't you lose hope of that promise being fulfilled? God came through with the birth of Isaac and then asked for him back as a sacrifice. Out of this request, we see another way God provides.

Prayer Focus: Our church worship services (6/10)

Passage: Job 38-42

Insight: The story of Job is a sad tale of having it all and losing it all. Job knows he has done nothing to deserve such devastation and he demands God explain himself. Finally, God speaks and what He shares is a glimpse into his authority over the earth.
