- 4) **Selfless Love** - Jesus said, "There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15:13 NLT)
- 5) **Gentle Correction** – "... if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness." (Galatians 6:1)


The Lord's Supper:
