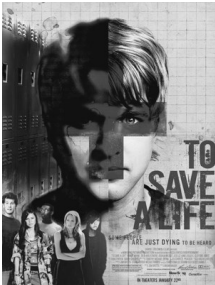
Student Ministries:

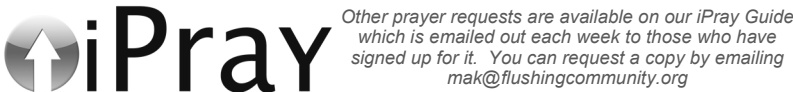
