


Wanna go to the next level?

# Digging Deeper

[Use these readings to prepare you for worship next week!]

**Monday:** 11.12.2012

**Prayer Focus:** Our church

**Passage:** Deuteronomy 24:17-22

**Insight:** As we begin our new series on orphan care, today's passage reminds us that this isn't a new issue. God is establishing the rules of the land that will help the new nation of Israel know how to function and work with each other. As this is taking place, He clearly puts laws in place to protect those who have no other way of protecting themselves.

What do these words tell us about God's character? How do you respond to the call to be people of justice?

**Tuesday:** 11.13.2012

**Prayer Focus:** Our Leadership Team

**Passage:** Galatians 3:26 - 4:7

**Insight:** As we consider the vitality of orphan care and adoption, we can't look beyond the fact that WE have been adopted spiritual. The metaphor that God uses to express our entrance into His family is best seen through adoption.

Have you ever considered your access to the family of God came through adoption? How does that make you feel to have all the rights and privileges to God's kingdom just like a natural born son or daughter?

**Wednesday:** 11.14.2012

**Prayer Focus:** Our National Leaders

**Passage:** Psalm 82

**Insight:** As you read this Psalm, see the difference between the unjust and wicked and how the writer speaks of the fatherless and oppressed. Sometimes as we go about life, it feels like the most undeserving and wicked people get all the breaks while those who have gone through so much get left out and abandoned.

God calls us to be a part of defending the weak and fatherless. God wants to use us to stand up for those who cannot stand up for themselves. How might God be showing you how to do this?

**Thursday:** 11.15.2012

**Prayer Focus:** Your School (teachers, admin, etc)

**Passage:** Isaiah 1:17-20

**Insight:** Isaiah has been ushered into the presence of God and He is warning the people to get rid of their empty religious rituals and get back to meaningful expressions of God's grace and mercy.

Earlier in this passage (11) God says "I've had enough burnt offerings" and then he says (16) how we must put our faith into action (wash, stop, seek, etc). What could change in your life in this same way?

**Friday:** 11.16.2012

**Prayer Focus:** Our Children's Ministry (baby - 6th gr)

**Passage:** Romans 8:12-17

**Insight:** We are not to be slaves to sin. We are better than that. We are children—adopted children—of the King of Kings and Lord of Lords! Nothing can tell us what to do except our Daddy (Abba Father). We our Father rejoices, we rejoice with Him. When our big brother Jesus suffers, we join Him in that suffering. Either way, we are not alone! We have a family that nothing can defeat! Praise the Lord!

Take time today to thank the Lord for your adoption and your place in His family!
