Digging Deeper

[Use these readings to prepare you for worship next week!]

Monday: 10.22.2012

Prayer Focus: Our church

Passage: Romans 13:1-7

Insight: We began a new teaching series yesterday on how we are to look at politics through a Christian perspective. Today's reading was written by Paul to a church that was located in the capital of the Roman empire.

As you read these words, what stands out to you that can be applied to our world today? What words do you find troubling or difficult to adopt? Why do you think that we are called to submit to all authority in this way?

Tuesday: 10.23.2012

Prayer Focus: Our Student Ministry (7-12)

Passage: 2 Samuel 15:1-15

Insight: Today's reading is a passage from David's rule over Israel where his son, Absalom, is positioning for political gain. Normally, a son would take over for his father and rule after his father has died. In this case, Absalom invests four years into convincing the people that David isn't interested in their needs but that if he were King, it would be different.

I read this and immediately it felt like our political system. We elect a President and spend 4 years convincing everyone he doesn't care about you. What stands out to you in this story?

Wednesday: 10.24.2012

Prayer Focus: Intercession (use the iPray Guide)

Passage: 1 Peter 2:13-17

Insight: I couldn't read this passage without considering it's author. Peter writes that we ought to submit ourselves to every authority no matter what. Is this the same person who years before tried to free Jesus by attacking one of the guards and cut off his ear? Peter is now proclaiming a new message ... one that speaks of peace and submission.

What stands out to you as you think about Peter's spiritual transformation? How does verse 15 motivate you to "do good" for others instead of depend on our government?

Thursday: 10.25.2012

Prayer Focus: Your School (teachers, admin, etc)

Passage: Daniel 6

Insight: One of my favorite stories from the Bible as a child was Daniel and the Lions Den. As you read it today, I hope that it is still as amazing as ever! We see a man who respects those in authority and is respected by those in authority ... but he knows his limitations, too. Daniel will not stop praying and seeking God—even in the face of certain death.

Daniel honors God and in return, God protects Daniel. What do we learn about the tension that exists between respecting authority and remaining faithful to the Lord?

Friday: 10.26.2012

Prayer Focus: Our Children's Ministry (baby - 6th gr)

Passage: Matthew 22:15-22

Insight: This Sunday, we will be looking at a particular aspect of politics ... taxes! Jesus was asked several times about his view on taxation to the Roman authorities and his answer is very revealing about how he views authority over us and finances in general.

As you read this passage today, what stands out to you as an application point? How do you presently view taxes and are you able to embrace Jesus' point of view?
