Prayer Focus: The Flushing Community

Passage: Genesis 12, 15, 17, 18

Insight: These 4 chapters give us glimpses into the relationship between God and his people. Abram was called by God with promises and commitments and those promises would change everything Abram knew ... including his name.

Prayer Focus: FCC Church Leadership

Passage: Genesis 21-22

Insight: God promised Abraham a great number of descendants but his wife was still barren—even at the age of 90. Wouldn't you lose hope of that promise being fulfilled? God came through with the birth of Isaac and then asked for him back as a sacrifice. Out of this request, we see another way God provides.

Passage: Genesis 24, 27-28

Insight: The glimpses of the story in today's reading reveal the next generation of God's faithfulness through Isaac. It also shows the twisted reality of brothers who were willing to do anything to get ahead. In a strange way, we continue to see God working through the plots of mankind.

Thursday: 06.14.2012

Prayer Focus: The sick and recovering (iPray)

Passage: Genesis 29-32

Insight: The story of Jacob marrying Leah and Rachel is fascinating and it sets the stage for a life-long feud between sisters (not that they needed any help with that I'm sure). As Jacob is facing his certain doom by seeing his brother Esau, he battles with the Lord himself and in this struggle, God blesses him and gives him the name Israel.

My Thoughts ...

Friday: 06.15.2012

Prayer Focus: Our church worship services (6/10)

Passage: Genesis 37, 39-41, 45

Insight: The story now turns to Israel's sons and especially the eldest of his favorite wife Rachel. Joseph is repeatedly given an unfair judgment but he remained faithful to the Lord and to those around him. God was at work through all those evil plots and eventually saves Israel's family in Egypt.
