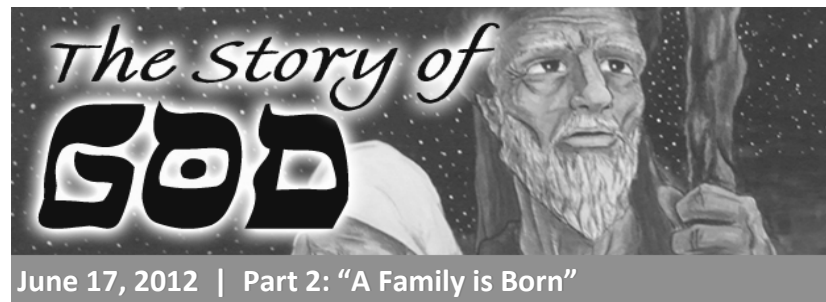
What will this gathering be like?

Monday: 06.18.2012

Prayer Focus: The Flushing Community

Passage: John 3:1-20

Insight: This Sunday, June 24, we are going to spend our day considering God's transformative love. In our reading today, we see Jesus teaching on the change that occurs in our life when we embrace the love God has for us.

My Thoughts ...

Tuesday: 06.19.2012

Prayer Focus: FCC Church Leadership

Passage: Galatians 2:11-21

Insight: When God's love get's a hold of us, it must change us because we are unable to be like we used to be before God. Paul is willing to argue with those who are allow their "old ways" (even the old ways of faith) to dictate their current behaviors. We must allow God's love to impact our present vision!

My Thoughts ...

Wednesday: 06.20.2012

Prayer Focus: Summer Youth Mission Trip

Passage: 1 John 3

Insight: This chapter reminds us that we cannot experience the fullness of God's love if we allow sin to rule our lives. Mistakes will be made but those who will allow God's love to wreck their life will see a change in them that is supernatural! Live by verse 18 ... no lip service love—real action based love it must be!!

My Thoughts ...

Thursday: 06.21.2012

Prayer Focus: The sick and recovering (iPray)

Passage: Matthew 5:43-48

Insight: How easy is it to continue to love those you already love? How easy is it to love friends, family and the wealthy? How about those you don't know ... those you find it challenging to be around ... your enemies or even the poor? Jesus challenges us to not only love them, but pray for them (which is God's deepest expression of love)!

My Thoughts ...

Friday: 06.22.2012

Prayer Focus: Our church worship services (6/24)

Passage: Mark 12:28-30

Insight: If you had to boil the Bible down to 1 word, we would say love. Further investigation reveals that we are to love vertically first (meaning love God with all our being). Then we are to reflect that love horizontally (or to each other). This is not optional nor up for discussion. As the church of Jesus, we are called to love and to be changed by that love.
