Digging Deeper

[Use these readings to prepare you for worship next week!]

Monday: 07.09.2012

Prayer Focus: Our church leadership

Passage: Joshua 24:13-27

Insight: The people of Israel made solemn promises to honor God. What has prevented you from keeping promises you made with sincere intentions?

Tuesday: 07.10.2012

Prayer Focus: The Flushing Community

Passage: Judges 17:1-13

Insight: Micah determined to set up his own forms of religious practice. Does the basis of your devotion and relationship with God function through the activities of others or through your own experience with him?

Wednesday: 07.11.2012

Prayer Focus: Our nation

Passage: 2 Chronicles 3:1-17

Insight: There is plenty more to read on the details of the temple in 1 Kings 5-8 if you're interested. But, based on the reading from Chronicles, how would you design a space to worship God if you had limitless resources and highly skilled craftsmen at your disposal?

Thursday: 07.12.2012

Passage: 1 Kings 19:9-18

Insight: Elijah has just demonstrated God's power to all of Israel, but Queen Jezebel is after him. God makes a promise to protect Elijah because he has been obedient to him, but he doesn't promise that it will be easy or comfortable.

Are we willing to be obedient to God even though it may upset those around us? Can we trust God enough to listen for his voice even if we feel that we are standing alone?

Friday: 07.13.2012

Passage: Ezekiel 2:1 - 3:15

Insight: God sends Ezekiel to the Israelites, even though he knows that they will not listen. God calls them "obstinate and stubborn", and declares that they have rebelled against him. Even when his people are disobedient, God gives them an opportunity to return to him!

Take a moment to examine your heart. Is there anything that you are being "obstinate and stubborn" about? How might God be gently calling you to return to him
