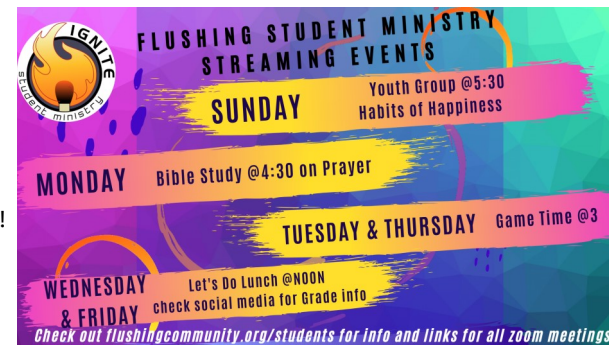

Part 3: Shoes that Bring Peace

How many pairs of shoes do you have and what are they for?

13 “Therefore, put on every piece of God’s armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. **14** Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God’s righteousness. **15** For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. **16** In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. **17** Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.” (Ephesians 6:13-17 NLT)

How does Paul make a connection to Isaiah’s words?

“How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of the messenger who brings good news, the good news of peace and salvation, the news that the God of Israel reigns!” (Isaiah 52:7 NLT)

How did Jesus speak about his gift of peace?

“I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don’t be troubled or afraid.” (John 14:27 NLT)

“The Trinity offers us this precise gift of community—a grounded connection with God, self, others, and the world. The way of Jesus therefore is an invitation to a way of living, loving, and relating—on earth as it is in God. While we may not always recognize it, we are all together in a web of mutual interdependence. When we recognize it on a spiritual level, we call it love.” (Father Richard Rohr - “The Foundation of Community”)

Sharing the Good News of Jesus ...

- 1) Personal (relational, mutual affection & concern)
- 2) Prayerful (living in relationship with God through conversation)
- 3) Peaceful (the confidence of sharing God’s love brings a centering peace)

Jesus said: **“I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world.”** (John 16:33 NLT)

How are you needing peace? How can you go and offer peace?

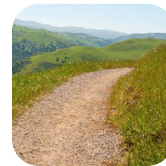
Believer Baptism:

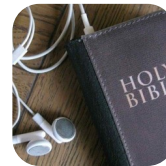
The Lord’s Supper:
