Part 4: Shield of Faith

Read Ephesians 6:10-18 Pastor Mike will be using English Standard Version today!

“Our faith is not faith in faith. Our faith is our faith in the faithfulness of Christ.” – Dr. Jesse Middendorf
What does this statement mean to you?

The armor of God is God’s very own armor in which He fights for us:
“The Lord looked and was displeased that there was no justice. He saw that there was no one, he was appalled that there was no one to intervene; so his own arm achieved salvation for him, and his own righteousness sustained him. He put on righteousness as his breastplate, and the helmet of salvation on his head; he put on the garments of vengeance and wrapped himself in zeal as in a cloak.... “The Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who repent of their sins,” declares the Lord.” (Isaiah 59:15-17, 20 NIV)

Jesus has won the spiritual battle on our behalf:
“... having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.” (Colossians 2:15 NIV)

What are some of the “flaming arrows of the evil one” and how does Jesus protect us from them?

Temptation see Hebrews 2:18; 4:14-15; 1 Corinthians 10:13

Accusation see 1 John 2:1; Romans 8:33-34

Deceit see John 1:17; 14:6; 17:17, 19; 8:31-32

“Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.” (Hebrews 12:1-2, ESV)
Our faith connects us. How has God used the faith of others to strengthen your faith?

“The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and he helps me. My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise him.” (Psalm 28:7, NIV)

Personal reflection this week:

- Who or what are you putting your faith in? Is it providing you the security and assurance Jesus does?
- How can trusting in who God is protect you from the flaming arrows of the evil one?
- How are you locking faith with others to stand firm against the enemy’s attacks?


The Lord’s Supper:
