ICE BREAKER:

Have you ever dreamed of inventing anything? If so, what was it and why is it needed?

Read: 1.3 - 1.7 of Dangerous Prayers (Groeschel)

What stood out to you in the reading?

What does God say about the condition of the human heart in Jeremiah 17:9?

How does this influence our worship? (Isaiah 29:13)

Read: Psalm 139

What stands out to you in the first 22 verses of this prayer?

"Search me, O God, and know my heart; **test me** and know my anxious thoughts.

Point out anything in me that offends you, and **lead me** along the path of everlasting life."

"I realize the closer I get to Jesus, the more I have to face my shortcomings. My pride. My selfishness. My lust. My critical spirit." (DP, p. 37) Do you agree with this statement?

:: Main Point from today's sermon ::

*"Instead of asking God to do something **FOR** you, ask Him to **REVEAL** something **IN** you."*

Read: Psalm 46:10. Are there ways you need to practice stillness in your life?

Read: Proverbs 3:5-7. Are there ways you need to practice readiness/trust in your life?
