ICE BREAKERS:

WIN/LOSE/DRAW ... come up with 10 examples of perfect love and put them on small pieces of paper. Have members of your Life Group or family pick one from a hat or small bowl and then give them 60-seconds to draw it out while other members are guessing the image.

READ: 1 Corinthians 13:1-13

How can Paul's words inspire us to live out our love toward others differently than we often do? What are the most challenging aspects of Paul's love characteristics?

Investigate together:

Take time looking over the Gospels and discovering ways that Jesus LIVED LOVE rather than SPEAK it.

READ: John 13:34-35. How can this new command that Jesus is giving change your life?

REFLECT: "You don't possess the power to love without of the presence of God's Spirit living in you!"

What role does the Holy Spirit play in your desire and ability to love others?

Is it possible to really love others without the Holy Spirit in someone's life?

This week's challenge: Today, flowers were distributed to demonstrate tangibly the Love of God to each life. Maybe you keep your flower as a reminder of God's love for you. OR, maybe you prayerfully consider who you could give your flower away to in order to communicate God's love for them.
